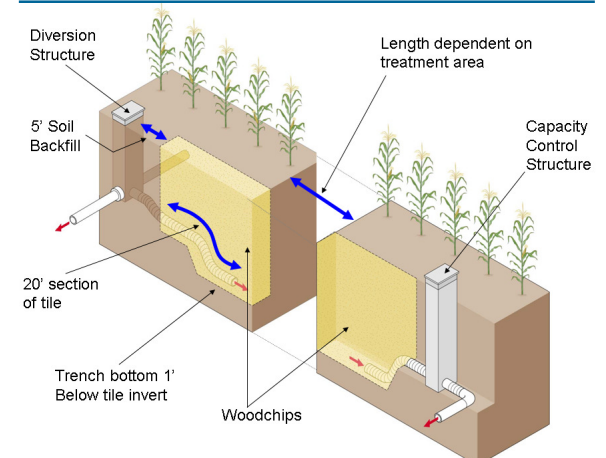

## PROGRAM INFO

Drainage water management is a practice that allows a producer to exercise greater control over a drainage system in such a way as to reduce drainage during certain times of the year (when less drainage is needed), and provide for adequate drainage when needed most. Drainage water management has the potential to improve water quality by reducing the quantity of nutrient enriched drainage water leaving fields, and provide production benefits by extending the period of time when water is available to plants. Bioreactors are a complimentary component of drainage water management that have proven to have significant reductions when designed properly.
