#### MINNESOTA STATE CAPITOL VISIT

#### LEGISLATIVE TOPICS BROUGHT TO THE CAPITOL

<u>Minnesota Earned Sick and Safe Time</u> and Paid Leave. The law is very costly for businesses. Potential for employee leave of 12 weeks. Who pays for the employees' wages and benefits during this time off. The confusing this causes employers. MN LICA recommends tightening reasons for using the leave and strongly questions the need for this program.

Gopher State One Call's law changes. The limit on refreshing option to one time and limit of the area to one mile total, measuring around the area. The rule interpretation that creates to small an area for most rural locate requests. This restriction creates the need for a meet and document submittal. Asking for modification to make rural areas easier to work with. MN LICA is concerned that the delayed locates will only result in increased costs to projects.

<u>Taxes and wasteful spending</u> – Minnesota can't afford to continue this trend. We went from an 18-billion-dollar surplus to a projected 6-billion-dollar shortfall. This needs to stop!

<u>Electrical vehicle mandate</u> needs to be removed, if not already.

<u>DNR</u> causing huge problems for farmers, landowners and contractors. They are delaying drainage projects by requiring very costly water retention designs and water control structures. MN LICA contractors have installed countless conservation projects and the wetland acres in Minnesota increase each year. Also, the prevailing wage laws required on conservation and county ditch projects now requiring contractors to pay union wages. This is a waste of limited resources that were enacted through past legislation. This hurt our businesses and limits the amount of work done because of limited funds.

<u>Public Water Inventory</u>; The DNR is in the process of reevaluating the state's public waters inventory. MN LICA's concern is that this will result in many additional miles of public waters, adding permit requirements from the DNR and opening routine maintenance to scrutiny and harassment by so-called environmental groups. MN LICA urges diligent oversight to ensure reasonable results.

# Safety Matters



Mounting and Dismounting Equipment

Because jumping down off large equipment is a common practice for construction workers, it's no surprise that lower back, knee, ankle and neck injuries occur more frequently. Regardless of the type of equipment you work with, mounting and dismounting safely should always be top of mind.

#### What You Can Do

When a person jumps from a height of more than one foot, the force that goes through the body is about 14 times the person's body weight. In other words, a 165-pound person who jumps out of construction equipment or any other high surface is exerting 2,310 pounds of force on their body.

This can cause injury to bones, tendons and cartilage. And if you're doing this activity multiple times every workday, the damage to the body can be extensive.

To lessen your risk of injuries, follow these simple mounting and dismounting instructions for trucks and other tall equipment or machinery.

- When using a new piece of machinery, become familiar with proper mounting and dismounting procedures.
- When dismounting and mounting, maintain three-point contact. This means having contact with the equipment by either one foot and two hands or one hand and two feet. The smaller the triangle you form with

your body, the more stable you are.

- Always face the vehicle, both when mounting and dismounting.
- Look at the surface below before stepping and make sure it is even to prevent ankle and knee injuries.
- Never mount or dismount moving equipment.
- Do not mount or dismount with anything, including tools, in your hands. Not only does it throw the body off-balance, it also reduces your chance of recovering your balance if you do slip. Use a drop rope to raise and lower supplies, tools and equipment instead.
- Handholds and footholds are on the equipment for a reason—use them.
- Wear appropriate clothing. Loose or torn clothing can get caught on equipment when you are jumping down instead of climbing down. In slippery conditions, wear proper footwear to prevent slipping hazards.
- Proper vehicle maintenance also contributes to the safe mounting and dismounting of equipment. Make sure running boards, treads, steps, footholds and platforms are kept clear. Hazards like ice, snow and grease could cause slips, trips and falls.

1 Tbsp. chopped sweet pickles


2-3 Tbsp. Mayonnaise
