




Best Practices:

- Ensure that manual swing barrier gates can be secured when opened or closed to prevent unintentional movement.
- Paint or tape swing barrier gates with reflective and distinguished markings to differentiate them from their surroundings. Install additional lighting near barrier gates.
- Conduct thorough travelway examinations to identify and mitigate hazards.
- Establish safe traffic patterns with proper signage.
- Be alert to road conditions and always keep a clear line of sight.

Maintain proper speed for road conditions.

MNLICA Participates in Conservation Drainage Network Presentation by Stu Frazeur

On April 7th MnLICA took part in the Conservation Drainage Network Annual Meeting, at the invitation of Mark Dittrich, Minnesota Department of Agriculture. The CDN is involved with moving drainage away from "just an outlet to a ditch" to managing and/or treating the water that leaves the systems.

The annual meeting was two days of on-line presentations by organizations ranging from the Ag Drainage Management Coalition to university professors, on topics from practices to measuring nutrient loss in a system.

MnLICA was represented by Vice President Stu Frazeur, with the theme of "Making Conservation Easy." One main point was that it shouldn't be a hard to obtain financial and technical support for producers to install a conservation practice. Further, we need to make it especially easy for those farmers that are "doing it wrong" so that they will be open to taking another step. We all know that soil is a precious thing, but some farmers don't get that message. But when a project moves slow, or is filled with frustration, that will make the farmer hesitant to make the next improvement. You can bet the neighbors will notice, too.

Another point was on working together, and Frazeur suggested that MnLICA could play an important part in training new technicians entering SWCDs, NRCS and other agencies. We know what works, what doesn't, and how to communicate about land improvement practices.





Easy Fresh Strawberry Pie

- 1 sheet refrigerated pie crust
- 3/4 cup sugar
- 2 tablespoons cornstarch
- 1 cup water
- 1 package (3 ounces) strawberry gelatin
- 4 cups sliced fresh strawberries
- Whipped cream, optional

• Preheat oven to 450°. Unroll crust into a 9-in. pie plate. Trim edge. Line unpricked crust with a double thickness of heavy-duty foil or parchment. Bake 8 minutes. Remove foil; bake 5 minutes longer. Cool on a wire rack.

• In a small saucepan, combine the sugar, cornstarch and water until smooth. Bring to a boil; cook and stir until thickened, about 2 minutes. Remove from the heat; stir in gelatin until dissolved. Refrigerate until slightly cooled, 15-20 minutes.

Meanwhile, arrange strawberries in the crust. Pour gelatin mixture over berries. Refrigerate until set. If desired, serve with whipped cream.
